

VOLUNTEER CONTRACT

At Memorial Day School our goal is to provide the broad variety of programs and activities that you would find at a much larger school. Our students need to experience a well-rounded educational experience that helps them to grow and develop, not only academically, but emotionally, spiritually, and physically. For that reason, it is an expectation that our parents will become actively involved in the school by volunteering time each year to helping in one or more ways, such as:

- Substitute Teaching
- Helping in the Media Center
- Working in the concession stand at school events
- Organizing and working at the Walk-A-Thon or Spring Fling
- Organizing and conducting school fundraisers
- Service on school committees
- Helping with prom, graduation, and baccalaureate
- Chaperoning field trips
- Helping in the school office
- Other options that become available throughout the year

As a member of the MDS family, a commitment of the equivalent of 15 service hours will be expected per family each year. For families unable to fulfill the 15 hour commitment, there will be a fee of \$10 per hour assessed at the end of the contract year cycle in April and billed accordingly.

Parents will be responsible for keeping track of their family hours by reporting them on the school website, www.memorialdayschool.com.

When parents have completed and reported the 15 hour commitment, no other documentation will be necessary.

Example (Equating Service Hours):

1 hour worked in or on behalf of the school = 1 service hour
